有關「賽馬會智家樂計劃」

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金於2018年撥款逾1億5千7百萬港元,展開為期四年的「賽馬會智家樂計劃」,協助全港26所非政府機構營運的綜合家庭服務中心及綜合服務中心,運用資訊科技提升家庭服務。本計劃結合跨界別力量,旨在善用資訊科技及數據分析,建立創新和實證為本的家庭服務模式,令服務使用者更加受惠於綜合家庭服務中心所提供的預防、支援和早期補救性服務,促進家庭幸福和諧。計劃亦會開發共享平台及推行知識轉移活動,提升前線員工專業能力,促進有效資訊共享、靈活學習及輕鬆共創。

計劃成效

預期受惠於本計劃的人數為75,000個服務使用者。而1,000個社會服務工作者亦能透過電子平台討論、學習及分享經驗。另預期超過170,000個公衆人士透過參與社區活動、登入網頁平台、觀看錄像、社交媒體等公衆教育和知識轉移活動,提升對家庭幸福的認識。除了發展創新的資訊科技,其應用將會減省綜合家庭服務中心的行政工作,從而可調配人力資源於加強預防性家庭服務。



About "Jockey Club SMART Family-Link Project"

Initiated by The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust in 2018 with a donation of over HK\$157 million, the four-year Jockey Club SMART Family-Link Project is a cross-sectoral collaboration to advance the use of Information and Communications Technology ("ICT") in family services. The Project aims to devise an innovative and evidence-based family service delivery model that leverages the effective use of ICT and data analytics to enable service users to better benefit from preventive, supportive and early remedial services provided by all 26 NGO-operated Integrated Family Service Centres (IFSCs) and Integrated Service Centres (ISCs) to promote family well-being. The Project develops an online platform for capacity building, co-creation and co-learning of frontline staff; and organises public education and knowledge transfer programmes to strengthen family functioning.

Project Objectives

Through cross-sectoral collaboration between NGOs and academia, the Project aims to:

Project Impacts

It is anticipated that about 75,000 individuals will benefit from the i-Action interventions, and around 1,000 social workers and frontline workers will leverage the i-TLS platform for learning and sharing. Over 170,000 members of the public will benefit indirectly through participating in community events, logging into the web portal, and viewing videos and social media as part of the public education and knowledge transfer initiatives. In addition to developing innovative ICT means for family service delivery, greater use of ICT in IFSCs/ISCs will minimize administrative work, where manpower could be redeployed towards preventive family services.

Service management system

A service management system will be developed for IFSCs/ISCs, covering client information system, casework, groups and programmes management, assessment tools, statistical reports and other administrative functions. The system will help reduce manual input and administrative work, facilitate early identification of at-risks cases and perform data analysis both at centre-level and aggregated across centres and NGOs. Participating IFSCs/ISCs will be equipped with electronic hardware and ICT applications to enhance service delivery.

Interventions leveraging ICT

採用科技 優化服務支援



計劃將推廣於家庭服務及活動設計中應用資訊科技。計劃將開發資訊科技工具,如手機應用程式及互動遊戲等,以聯繫家庭服務使用者,強化家庭功能,讓更多家庭更易接觸家庭服務。

The Project will promote the use of ICT in service delivery, programme design and planning in family service. ICT tools, like mobile apps, interactive games and others will be developed to engage family service users and strengthen family functions.

開發共享平台提昇專業能力



An online platform will be developed to facilitate IFSCs/ISCs staff in sharing common information, useful resources and practice wisdom, both within the IFSCs/ISCs and across different centres in a co-learning e-circle. Online training courses that the staff can enrol in at their convenience will also be developed.

透過社交媒體活動、新聞發佈會、大衆傳媒發佈、媒體訪問、標誌性大型社區和公衆教育活動,提升公衆對家庭功能的證本正向家庭方案、實用手冊和實踐,在家庭論壇中發佈,鼓勵更多社工於舉辦家庭活動時使用資訊科技。



Social media events, press events, mass media dissemination, media interviews, flagship mass community events, and public education campaigns will be utilised to increase public knowledge and understanding of healthy family functioning. Evidence-based positive family protocols, manuals, and practices will be produced and disseminated in family forums to encourage more social workers to organise family-based activities using ICT.

Big data analysis and evaluation

香港大學公共衞生學院將會分析在計劃中搜集到的大數據,幫助政策制訂者、綜合家庭服務中心營運者和個別社工因應數據分析資料策劃及主動調整服務以滿足未來需要。香港大學公共衞生學院並會於個人、社區和系統層面,對本計劃進行整體效果評估。
